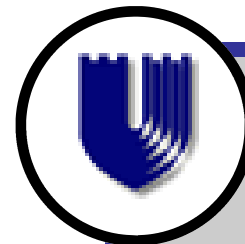

ONS Radiation Therapy Course

ONS has expanded its educational offerings with the development of a Radiation Therapy Course. This course, is designed for inpatient and ambulatory care nurses, and is offered by Radiation Therapy Trainers.



The content of the one-day course is appropriate for those who are new to radiation therapy as well as for those who would like a comprehensive review on the topic. Principles of radiation therapy, new radiation treatment modalities, and management of side effects are among the course key topics. Course participants will receive the ONS Manual for Radiation Oncology Nursing Practice (Third Edition).

Upon completion of this course, participants will receive 7 contact hours of continuing education credit.

The ONS Radiation Therapy Course is a one-day program that covers the following topics:

- **Principles of Radiation Therapy**
- **New Radiation Treatment Modalities**
- **Management of Radiation Side Effects**

Directions:

From I-85 North: Exit onto NC 147 (Durham Freeway). Take exit 15B off of Durham Freeway. Turn Right onto Fulton Street. Turn left onto Erwin Road. Turn right onto Trent Drive. Hanes House is immediately on your right, but you will need to park in the garage on the left up a bit more on Trent Drive.

From I-85 South: Take the Hillandale Rd Exit (#174A). Turn left onto Hillandale Rd. At 4th stop light road will become Fulton Street. Keep going straight. Turn left onto Erwin Road. Turn right onto Trent Drive. Hanes House is immediately on your right, but you will need to park in the garage on the left up a bit more on Trent Drive.
