# Educator Academy

The Educator Academy is a series of classes that have been designed to provide information for the nurse who serves as an educator. This educator can be a clinical nurse educator, nurse manager of education, unit based educator, or preceptor. The series consists of 6 classes, addressing topics from "The Basics" to "Patient Education".

## DAY 1: THE BASICS

This day includes information on the educational process. Topics include developing appropriate and measurable goals, how to develop an educational offering using the educational process, and how to utilize a shared governance model to facilitate the educational process.

## DAY 2: FROM CLASSROOM TO BEDSIDE

This offering meets the needs of our Advanced Preceptors. Day 2 provides skills for the preceptor to facilitate the transition of a new nurse to the bed side. The day includes information on how to get organized, how to build a team, coaching skills, learning contracts, and how to become a better mentor.

## DAY 3: TEACHING OUTSIDE OF THE BOX

An inter-active and technology day. This day incorporates using new and different technology methods for education. Topics include how to create an audiovisual

computer based slide show to support an educational offering. Gaming, audience response, and Wiki page utilization are also reviewed. This class takes place in a computer lab which allows the participants the ability to have some hands-on experience.

## DAY 4: BLENDED LEARNING

What is the best way to incorporate Low Fidelity and High Fidelity simulation into your educational offerings? By utilizing the blended learning approach to education. Methods of blended learning that will be discussed include computerized learning, case studies, and role playing. Introduction to the Sim Suite and a demonstration of SimMan will be included in this day.

## DAY 5: EVALUATION

Why do we evaluate our offerings? Even though you may not be providing continuing education hours, proper evaluation validates the educational process. This class provides you with the who, what, where, when, and why of evaluation...as well as how to make the evaluations meaningful.

## DAY 6: PATIENT EDUCATION

This day focuses on the educational process used for patient education. How do you determine your patient's learning style? What methods are available and effective to use to teach your patient? These questions and more will be discussed and answered.

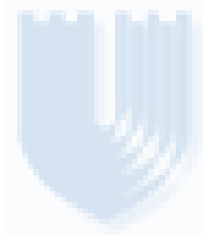
